Mineola: Mineola ISD will host their first community-wide Career Fair for students and families on Monday, October 16 from 12:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The fair will host more than 30 local and regional businesses to share information regarding career and job opportunities with students and their families.

Participating businesses and programs include: EZ Router, Longhorn Ford, Ag Power, Mineola Community Bank and KMOO radio

An added component is the adult education opportunity to solicit interest in expanding courses to include adult training for the community. Students will be able to drop lowest grade, if they bring their parents to the fair between 4-7 p.m.

Booths and exhibits will be set up in the gym, back parking lot, and in front of the high school to showcase equipment and types of jobs within these industries.

A helicopter from Flight For Life will be landing in front of the high school at 12:30 p.m.

KMOO radio will be running commercials for vendors during the fair. Students will be doing the voice for the commercials throughout the day.

Students from primary through high school will be allowed to visit with experts from local businesses about a career pathway and how strong academic skills build towards a successful career.

This event is a result of the partnership with Mineola Foundation, Inc. and is planned to occur annually.
