Weenie Dog Race



RACES:

- Qualifying races will be determined by heats and heats will be determined by the number of dogs registered and placed in the heats in the order of registration date.
- There will be two brackets, a championship bracket, and a consolation bracket.
- Dogs losing in the championship bracket will go to the consolation bracket with a one-time option to “buy back” into the championship bracket on the next qualifying heat, providing there are enough registered dogs for a second championship heat, otherwise they must go to the consolation bracket.
- Races begin promptly at 4:00 p.m. on race day - Saturday, September 24, 2022.
- Each dog is guaranteed at least two races.
- Races will go on as scheduled - no refunds due to bad weather cancellation or other circumstances.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Dogs must be certified dachshunds – This does not mean they have to be AKC registered but must have the specific breed characteristics as stated by the AKC. The Mineola Chamber of Commerce has the right to disqualify any dog if there is a question of the breed or size that may give an unfair advantage.
- All dogs must have current shots. Rabies in particular. Owners must provide a shot record.
- Races are assigned by order of receipt of a complete registration packet, i.e., registration form, entry fee check, and current shot record.
- You may bring your dog’s favorite toy. (Toy may not be bigger than 8 inches).
- No food (human or dog food) or other pets are allowed in the racetrack area.
- All dogs “must” be on a leash until race and owners are responsible for their own dogs.
- Owners are required to clean up after their dog’s accidents.
- Dogs and owners should be on their best behavior (i.e. no fighting, biting, or aggressiveness by humans or animals)
- Only one owner/handler is allowed in the racetrack area at any time.
- No waving blankets or other large items at the start of the race.
- A first and second place prize will be given from the championship bracket and a first place consolation prize will be given from the consolation bracket.
